



Spring 2019 Fellow Group Presentations

Overview

- **There are 15 partner organizations bringing together over 280 fellows at our 2019 Spring Congress in Washington, DC. During the morning of our first Congress day, May 28, each group of fellows will get the chance to come on stage and introduce themselves to the rest of the fellows from around the world.**
- There will be an optional workshop the evening of Monday, May 27 at the Capital Hilton Hotel in Washington to help groups prepare for their introductory presentations.

Content

- Presentations should not exceed 3 minutes in length.
- Pick music to be played as your group walks to the stage (called a walk-up song).
- Prepare remarks or a skit to represent the spirit of the group to the full Congress.
- Include which countries are represented by the fellows as well as your fellowship theme(s).
- Include a message for the audience about any of the following: your shared experiences in the U.S., lessons learned from fellowship, your collective passions, what you hope to accomplish once you return home, or what your group hopes to achieve during the Congress week.

Checklist

- Choose a captain to represent the group for presentation logistics. This person will be responsible for sending your group's slides/photos and song choices to Congress organizers.
- Select photos for up to 2 slides to be used during your presentation.
- Create a script for your time on stage and practice it together. Speakers should know what they will be saying and practice their scripts before presenting.

- Presentations should be finalized and submitted to Gabriel Bastomski by 9pm on Monday, May 27.
